

## **Michel Boris ZAITZEFF**

French born violinist, Michel Boris Zaitzeff trained with illustrious professors such as Liev Zaitzeff, Josef Gingold, Ivan Galamian, Franco Gullish and Tadeusz Wronski. His chamber music studies were with Daniel Guilet, Menahem Pressler, Gyorgy Sebok and Janos Starker, at Indiana University where he received his Bachelor of Music and his Master of Music degrees.

Professionally, Michel Boris Zaitzeff was a founding member of the Hamilton String Quartet and a member of various Canadian orchestras including the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra and the C.B.C. Radio Orchestra as Assistant Concertmaster and Concertmaster. He has toured with the Montreal Symphony Orchestra as well. As a soloist, he has performed with Canadian and French orchestras and has given recitals and chamber music concerts in Canada, the U.S.A., Mexico, Italy, Germany, and France.

Michel Boris Zaitzeff has been professor of violin in various universities and conservatories in Canada and France. He is now professor of violin at the Conservatoire National de Musique in Roubaix (France) and at the Staatliche Hochschule für Musik in Trossingen (Germany). He is a regular Visiting Professor of Violin at the Jacobs School of Music at Indiana University and is also a jury member of Canadian, American and French competitions, and gives master classes in Canada, the U.S.A., Germany, Sweden, and France.
