1. Admission to the BFA is by portfolio & application. See office or website for instructions.
2. The BFA Pre-Art-Conservation Major requires 110-135 credit hours in art, 55 of which must be taken at DU or with DU Faculty. Excess art credit will not count. Normally, the minimum art requirement is 118, but if some requirements are waived, it can be as low as 110.
3. Credit earned with less than a "C-" grade cannot be applied toward the major or minor. The overall GPA in the major must be at least 3.3.
4. Of the 189 credit hours required for the BFA degree, a minimum of 75 credit hours must be upper division (2000-3000 level).
5. A student may register for a maximum of 10 independent study credits. ARTS 3915 Advanced Problems in Art may be taken in studio areas where all courses in a sequence have been completed.
