

## SCHOOL OF ART AND ART HISTORY FINANCIAL AID REQUEST FORM

This form is used by the School of Art and Art History in conjunction with information provided by the Graduate School and the Financial Aid office to determine departmental financial aid. Graduate students seeking need-based financial aid must also submit the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) form and should talk to the Financial Aid Office about loans. Do not accept loans until departmental aid (below) has been allocated.

\_\_\_\_\_ Graduate Tuition Scholarships (merit based)

All regular status and provisional status graduate students are eligible (except students with more than 10 hours of incompletes). Scholarships are usually given in 5 hour increments. They provide tuition remission.

\_\_\_\_\_ Graduate Research and Gallery Assistantships (merit based)

Only regular status students are eligible. Graduate Research Assistantships are awarded by quarter and provide a stipend and tuition remission. They may be full- (20 hours work per week), half- (ten hours work per week), or quarter- (five hours work per week) time appointments. The GRA will be assigned to assist a member of the faculty, the Curator of Visual Resources, or to work in the school's art gallery.

\_\_\_\_\_ Graduate Teaching Assistantships (merit based)

Graduate Teaching Assistantships are awarded by quarter and provide a stipend and tuition remission. They may be full-time (20 hours work per week), or part time appointments. GTAs will be assigned to assist a member of the faculty and may teach their own course after a quarter of training.

\_\_\_\_\_ Graduate Work Study (need based)

All regular status, full-time graduate students who are U.S. citizens or permanent residents and are not in default of an educational loan are eligible. The work study student will be assigned to assist a member of the faculty, the Curator of Visual Resources, or in the school's art gallery and will work a specified number of hours.

\_\_\_\_\_ Colorado Graduate Grants (need based)

Certified residents of Colorado, enrolled full time as regular-status graduate students who demonstrate need, do not have any incompletes, and are not in default of an educational loan are eligible. Certification form available in Office of Graduate Studies.

\_\_\_\_\_ Carl Perkins Loan (need based)

This loan is only available upon recommendation of the department. No interest is due while enrolled full time. Payments begin 9 months after full time enrollment ceases. Interest is 5%.
