

Higher Education / Student Life Graduate Assistantships Application Directions

Positions (6) open for 2010-2011 Academic Year:

- 2 positions for Graduate Assistant, Campus Activities (CA)
- 1 position for Graduate Assistant, Citizenship and Community Standards (CCS)
- 3 positions for Graduate Resident Director, Housing and Residential Education (HRE)

Eligibility:

Only applications from new, incoming, students in the Higher Education Master's program will be reviewed.

Priority consideration will be given to those applicants who are enrolling in the **College Student Development** concentration. *If you are considering the Diversity and Higher Learning concentration, you may still apply for an assistantship; however, your case will be reviewed by Campus Life and the Higher Education program as an exception.*

Positions will be offered only to those applicants who have been accepted into the Higher Education Program.

Application Instructions:

Submit a current resume and cover letter that clearly states the assistantship for which you are applying. The cover letter should address your unique interests, experiences, and qualifications for the position. If applying for multiple positions, submit a **separate resume and cover letter that lists your specific qualifications for each position for which you are applying.**

Assistantship application materials should be submitted to highered@du.edu at the same time the application for the academic program is submitted online.

Selection Time Line:

Each assistantship application will be reviewed by Student Life and qualified candidates will be invited to interview on campus on March 11 and 12, 2010. Higher Education admissions interviews will be conducted within this same timeframe.

Award Notification:

Applicants will be notified of their award by mail upon acceptance to the Morrige College of Education Higher Education Program and will be contacted by the appropriate department within Student Life by April 15, 2010.
