

## Medication Administration Policy

The Fisher Early Learning Center is committed to your child's health and well-being. Our trained staff and nurse consultant will make every attempt to accommodate requests for medication administration; however, Fisher abides by the State of Colorado guidelines and regulations for health and safety. Please make sure that you have read and understand the medication policies of the Fisher Early Learning Center. These policies can be found in the *Health and Safety Handbook*.

Medications administered at the Fisher Early Learning Center must be requested and signed by a licensed health care provider (M.D., P.A., D.O., and N.P.). Medications must be in the original container and have the original label. Prescription drugs will be given for the prescribed time, while over the counter medications will only be given for up to 3 consecutive days, unless otherwise directed by a licensed health care provider.
