



Study Abroad Photo Contest

Share your favorite photos from your Study Abroad travels and experiences!

Take this opportunity to share your favorite photos with the rest of the DU community by entering the annual Study Abroad Photo Contest. Winners will be announced at the Crimson and Gold Global Gala on Wednesday, January 25th. Winning photos will be displayed in Craig Hall in March.

Eligibility

To enter you must be a DU student who participated in a study abroad or international service learning program that began sometime between January and December 2011, or who participated in an academic year-long program beginning in Fall Quarter 2010.

Categories & Judging

Winning photos will be selected in six categories. (Only one winning photo per student.)

1. **Cultural Interaction** — students interacting with local people
2. **DU Student(s) Abroad** — DU students in a foreign location
3. **People** — local people
4. **Places** — buildings, landmarks or other scenery
5. **Food, Flora and Fauna** — local food, plants or animals
6. **Top 5 Facebook Favorites** - chosen by our Facebook followers. Watch for more details on how you can help decide the favorites.

Photos will be judged on technical and artistic merit as well as relevance to contest categories. Entries should in some way represent the ideals of study abroad, which may include academic learning, cultural appreciation and sensitivity, international awareness, or interaction with the host culture.

Submission Guidelines

1. Photos must have been taken outside of the U.S. while participating in a study abroad or international service learning program commencing between January and December 2011, or while participating in an academic year program commencing in Fall Quarter 2010.
2. You must have taken the photo, or if you are in the photo, it must have been taken with your camera.
3. Photos cannot contain any display of alcoholic beverages or illegal activities.
4. Photos must be submitted in digital format (JPEG file type).
5. A completed entry form must be completed for each photo. The form can be found at: https://udenver.qualtrics.com/SE/?SID=SV_bavUGdlv6nLJNyY
6. After completing the entry form you will be asked to send the photo as an email attachment. Send the email to duabroad@du.edu. **Only one entry per email.**
7. You can submit a maximum of five photos, but **only 1 photo per category.**
8. **DEADLINE:** The deadline for submissions is 4:30pm on **Wednesday, January 11, 2012.**
9. All photos will become the property of the DU Study Abroad Office. By submitting your photos, you are giving DU permission to use your photo in various displays and marketing activities, publications, and/or on the web for the purpose of promoting study abroad at DU.
