



## Verification of Completion of Judicial Sanctions to Study Abroad

The University of Denver does NOT allow students that are on probation to participate in a study abroad program. This includes long-term and short-term programs on either DU and Non-DU programs.

However, if you are on probation when you applied to study abroad, but will be off probation prior to the start of your program, you must complete this sanctions form verifying that you have completed your requirements. (Example: You are due to finish probation at the end of winter quarter, and plan to attend a study abroad program for the fall term.) **This form is required to be eligible to study abroad.**

You MUST get the signature of a Citizenship and Community Standards staff member on this form verifying that you have completed the sanctions. Regardless of your period of probation, you are not in "good judicial standing" until all sanctions are completed. This form must be submitted to the Study Abroad Office by June 1<sup>st</sup> for fall or full academic year programs, November 20<sup>th</sup> for winter quarter or spring semester programs, or February 15<sup>th</sup> for the spring quarter programs.
