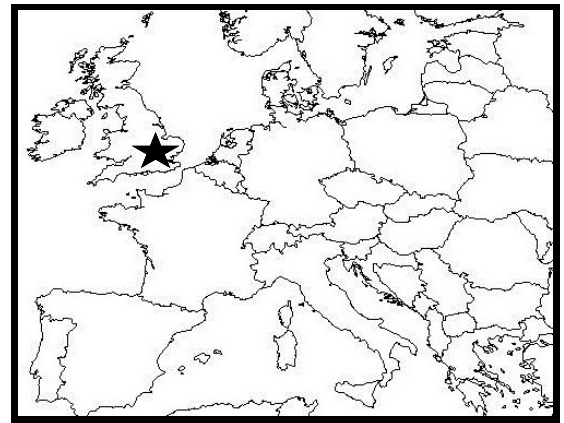

## PROGRAM

Enroll in courses with local students and faculty at Goldsmiths, University of London, and be a part of this innovative British university and its student body of about 8,000 students. ## ACADEMICS

## LOCATION: LONDON, ENGLAND, UK

London is an amazing place to be a student, because there's so much to see and do. Dr. Samuel Johnson once said, "When a man is tired of London, he is tired of life." The city is full of history and traditional quaint corners, yet it's the trend-setting, high-tech city of the United Kingdom. The Goldsmiths campus is in New Cross, South East London. The New Cross neighborhood has a flavor of its own and is in the London Borough of Lewisham—one of South East London's major shopping centers; it's also within walking distance of Greenwich, the Thames, and Greenwich Park. It's a lower-cost base for experiencing London and is a neighborhood where Londoners actually live and work. The London city center is a 15-minute subway ride away, and the University is connected to the East London Tube line.

## HOUSING & MEALS

A variety of accommodation within walking distance of campus is available. All rooms are singles with kitchen and bathroom facilities on each hall that are shared with local and international students (see [website](#)).

## CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

Besides exploring London, Goldsmiths has a very active student body. The award-winning Goldsmiths Students' Union provides exciting extracurricular experiences and services. # HOW TO APPLY

⇒ **Attend Study Abroad 101**

⇒ **Attend a Regional Advising Session**

Mandatory if you are considering the UK or Ireland. See website for schedule (same link as above).

⇒ **Meet with an international education advisor.**

If you already have one, make sure you know where it is and when it expires.

⇒ **Apply to study abroad!**

- DU short-answer essays
- Music majors only:* completed "Lamont School of Music—Course Approvals" Form
- Official transcript(s) from other universities attended, if applicable
- Non-Cherrington students will be charged a \$50 application fee to their DU account.

**Note:** *Cherrington status may be revoked at any time due to a change in your student conduct or academic status. Also, the OIE will request your DU transcript; check and clear any holds now to avoid delays in processing your application!*

## PROGRAM APPLICATION: DUE AFTER YOU'VE BEEN NOMINATED

Once you've been nominated for this program, you will be required to submit the following:

- Completed "Visiting and Exchange Students Application Form" (downloadable from their [website](#)) (+ 1 photocopy). *Please leave the "10 Fees" Section blank.*
- Completed "Housing Application Study in London Programme" Form (+ 1 photocopy)
- 1 passport-sized photograph for the housing application. *Write your name on the back of the photo.*
- 1 faculty reference letter
- Music majors seeking to take performance classes must submit an audition recording that contains two contrasting pieces, not exceeding 10 minutes, either solo or with accompaniment.*
- A portfolio of your work if applying for practice-based art or design courses*
