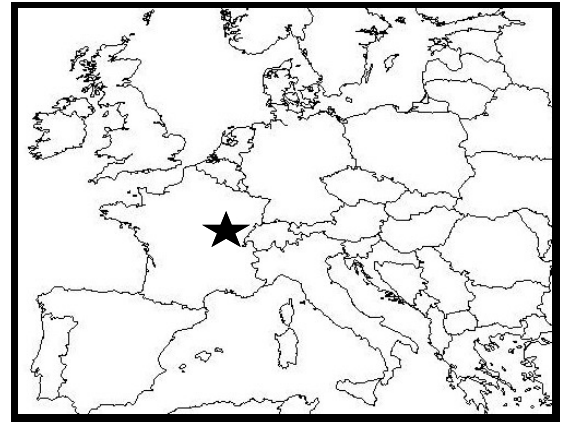

## PROGRAM

The Ecole Supérieure de Commerce de Dijon Bourgogne (also known as ESC Dijon) was founded in 1900 and now has a student population of nearly 1,200. Although the majority of students are French, there is a large number of international students and many classes are taught in English. This enables you to be integrated and directly enrolled into a leading French Grande Ecole without knowing French! The system of Grandes Ecoles is an elite and uniquely French model of higher education, making admission as a degree student intensely competitive.

## ACADEMICS

ESC Dijon offers a variety of courses in accounting, business law, business administration, finance, human resources, information systems, international business, management, marketing, and statistics. You may choose from business courses taught in English, French, German, or Spanish. You are required to take one French language class and one culture class (may be taken either in French or in English). Aside from the language and culture classes, all of the coursework is business-related.

## LOCATION: DIJON, FRANCE

The French recently selected Dijon (population 152,000 with nearly 25,000 students), as one of the top three places to live in France. The city is the capital of the region of Burgundy, which is rich in culture, historic architecture, fine food, and wine. Dijon is situated on the northern edge of the Côte d'Or wine region and is a short train ride away from the Alps. Paris is less than a two-hour train ride away. The ESC is just a short walk from the main shopping areas in the city center.

## HOUSING & MEALS

At the Burgundy School of Business, you have three housing options: you can live with a local French host family; you can rent an apartment (the school will assist with your search); or you can apply to stay in student residences. If you choose to live with a family, you may opt to cook for yourself or the family can provide meals for you. Commute times vary, but Dijon is not a large city and you will be no more than 40 minutes from the school. Most students are much closer.

## CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

ESC Dijon clubs offer a variety of activities and sports; there's everything from wine tasting to skiing or professional societies. One group in particular, called the "Melting Potes," consists of French students devoted to integrating international students into the student body. Of course, Dijon is also teeming with cultural events and is conveniently located for excursions to other destinations in France and Europe.

### Student Costs\*\*:

- Housing & Meals

The cost of living varies in other cities and countries. Talk to returnees from the program to find out what personal expenses to expect, but remember that they vary by lifestyle. Check [www.xe.com](http://www.xe.com) for current exchange rates.

**ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED. APPLY BY THE DEADLINE (SEE REVERSE SIDE FOR DATES). APPLICATIONS ARE REVIEWED BY THE STUDY ABROAD OFFICE AND THEN FORWARDED TO THE PROGRAM. YOU MAY NOT RECEIVE AN ADMISSIONS DECISION FROM THE PROGRAM FOR SEVERAL WEEKS.**

- Non-Cherrington students will be charged a \$50 application fee to their DU account.

**Note:** Cherrington status may be revoked at any time due to a change in your student conduct or academic status.

- 1 passport-size photograph; write your name on the back and place the photo in a sealed envelope
- Copy of passport (preferably scanned)
- Copy of your resume (+ 1 photocopy)
- Description of college-level business classes you have taken (+ 1 photocopy)
- Proof from your insurance company that you are personally insured abroad (+ 1 photocopy)
- Course registration form (download from [www.bsbu.com](http://www.bsbu.com)) (+ 1 photocopy)
- Completed accommodation questionnaire (download from [www.bsbu.com](http://www.bsbu.com)) (+ 1 photocopy)

**Note:** The Study Abroad Office will request your DU transcript; check and clear any holds now to avoid delays in processing your application!
