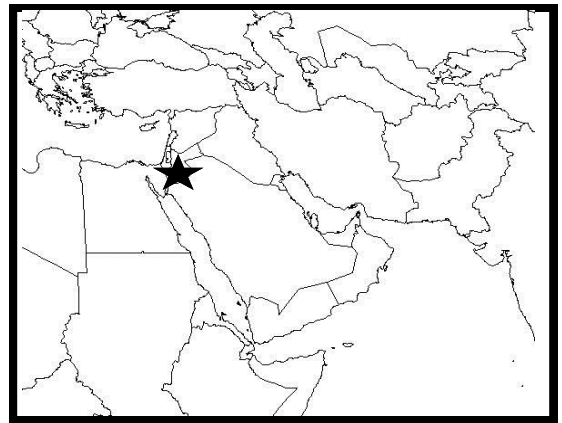

### PROGRAM

In cooperation with CIEE, you have the opportunity to participate in the Language and Culture program in Jordan. The CIEE Jordan Study Center is located opposite the main gates of the University of Jordan campus. The University of Jordan was founded in 1962 and is the first public four-year institution of higher education in Jordan. Nearly 35,000 students attend the University of Jordan, including 1,800 international students. You will have access to facilities of the University, but your classes are created specifically for CIEE students. You will not be in classes with Jordanian students.

### ACADEMICS

All participants will take two language classes: Arabic Language and Colloquial Jordanian Arabic. You will also take two area studies courses taught in English. Fields of study include anthropology, culture, economics, history, literature, political science, and religion. Four classes is considered a full course load. Internships are also available; you may opt to take the internship course instead of one of the area studies courses. Placements vary but tend to be with non-governmental organizations. An internship is an excellent way to not only gain work experience abroad but also to explore first hand regional and local issues and gain a deeper understanding of Jordanian life and culture.

### LOCATION: AMMAN, JORDAN

This program is based in the modern Arab city of Amman (pop. 2.5 million). Jordan is bordered by Syria, Iraq, Saudi Arabia, and Israel. It is a nation at the crossroads of ancient traditions and modern development, and serves as a conduit of trade and communication in the region and beyond.

### HOUSING & MEALS

You may opt to live with a host family or in an off-campus apartment with other CIEE students. The host families include breakfast and dinner on weekdays and three meals on the weekends. The apartments do not include meals.

### CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

CIEE organizes cultural and educational activities to museums, theaters, and galleries as well as longer excursions to Petra and to northern Jordan. Peer language tutors are available and are a great way to meet Jordanian students. Volunteer placements and internships organized by CIEE are great ways to immerse yourself in Jordanian culture, meet new people and learn more about local issues. If you live with a host family, spend time getting to know them. Speak Arabic as much as possible—even if you are a beginner, people will appreciate the effort. Take advantage of all the opportunities provided to you. It is up to YOU to make the most of your study abroad experience!

#### Student Costs\*\*:

- Meals (if living in an apartment)

## ⇒ Attend Study Abroad 101

- DU short-answer essays
- Official transcript(s) from other universities attended, if applicable
- Non-Cherrington students will be charged a \$50 application fee to their DU account.

*Note: Cherrington status may be revoked at any time due to a change in your student conduct or academic status. Also, The OIE will request your DU transcript; check and clear any holds now to avoid delays in processing your application!*

## PROGRAM APPLICATION: DUE AFTER YOU'VE BEEN NOMINATED

- Once you have been nominated for this program, you will be required to submit the following:
  - CIEE online application (Personal Data Form, Academic Information Form, Personal Statement): fill out & submit to CIEE at <http://www.ciee.org/study/apply/>. Print & submit the CIEE confirmation
- email with your DU application. *DU students do NOT need to pay the CIEE application fee.*
- Home School Nomination Form (This will be sent electronically & completed by your O.I.E. advisor.)
  - Academic Evaluation (Use the CIEE online form to select your evaluator who will complete the form and submit it to CIEE.)
- Six passport-sized photographs: *These must be in color and printed on photo paper. Please write your name on the back of each photo and submit them in an envelope.*
- Optional: CIEE Scholarship application: See <http://www.ciee.org/study/scholarships.aspx> for more details regarding CIEE scholarships and application procedures. *Someone from the financial aid office must complete a portion of the application before you submit it.*
