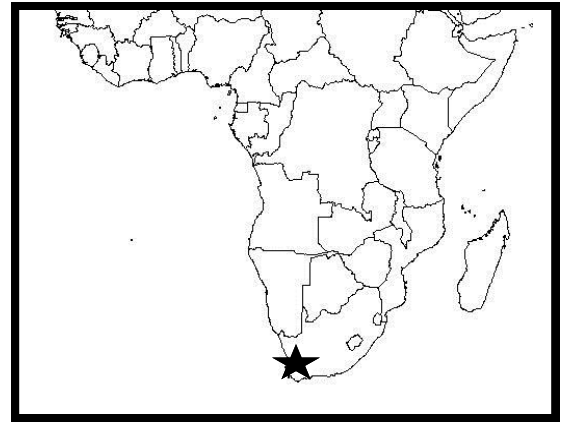

## PROGRAM

This program is coordinated by Interstudy, and offers students the opportunity to study at Stellenbosch University. Stellenbosch University was founded in 1866, and enrolls 24,600 students. Since Stellenbosch is officially an Afrikaans university, most courses are taught in Afrikaans. Faculties include AgriSciences, Arts and Social Sciences, Education, Engineering, Law, Science, Theology, and Economic and Management Sciences. Some regular university courses are offered in English, and the International Programs Stellenbosch University (IPSU) office also coordinates additional classes in English designed for international students.

## ACADEMICS

Most English-speaking students will take classes offered by the IPSU. Fields of study offered by IPSU include history, political science, economics, sociology, and theology, among others. Students also have the opportunity to take introductory courses in languages such as Xhosa or Afrikaans. You may also apply to participate in a 13.5 quarter credit service learning course entitled Learning for Sustainable Community Engagement. This course is typically offered in fall; spring study abroad participants should check with Interstudy to see if the course will be offered.

## LOCATION: STELLENBOSCH, SOUTH AFRICA

Stellenbosch (pop. 118,700) was founded in 1679, and continues to maintain its historic character. Though a small city, Stellenbosch is a modern center for education, business, and agriculture. The town is located 34 miles from Cape Town and 12 miles from the beach. Stellenbosch is located in the country's beautiful Western Cape region, and offers a wide variety of cultural and outdoor activities.

## HOUSING & MEALS

You will live on campus in a single bedroom with shared kitchen, bathroom, and common area. A mix of South African and international students will share your accommodations. Meals are not included.

## CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

Stellenbosch University's student center, "Neelsie," is the social center of the campus and houses many student societies. Sports enthusiasts will want to get involved with one of the University's competitive or recreational athletic clubs. The University offers frequent theater and musical performances. You are encouraged to consider participating in the service learning course or non-credit community service program, as these options will provide you with opportunities to get to know members of your host country outside the context of the University. These experiences will expand your understanding of South African cultures and current issues facing South African communities.

### Student Costs\*\*:

# HOW TO APPLY

## ⇒ Attend Study Abroad 101

- DU short-answer essays
- Official transcript(s) from other universities attended, if applicable
- Non-Cherrington students will be charged a \$50 application fee to their DU account.

**Note:** Cherrington status may be revoked at any time due to a change in your student conduct or academic status. Also, the OIE will request your DU transcript; check and clear any holds now to avoid delays in processing your application!

## PROGRAM APPLICATION: DUE AFTER YOU'VE BEEN NOMINATED

Once you have been nominated for this program, you will be required to submit the following:

- Interstudy online application: <http://www.interstudy.org>  
DO NOT pay the application fee! Skip this step (7). You will receive an error message after step 9 saying you have to complete step 7 to finish. Ignore this—Interstudy will later go back in to your application and check off the application fee as complete.
- Home Institution Approval Form
- Two Academic Recommendations (use Interstudy forms)
- Six (6) passport-sized photos (2x2). These must be passport/ID—type photos on photo paper. Please print your name on the back of each photo, and place them in a sealed envelope.
- Stellenbosch application—you will receive this application from Interstudy after submitting your initial online application. Students interested in the service learning course should indicate this on the application, and will be provided with instructions on additional requirements.
