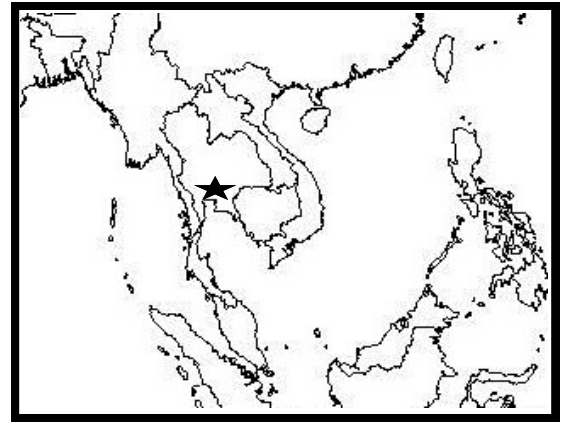

PROGRAM

Students enroll directly at Mahidol University where they take classes with local Thai and other international students. The semester culminates with a four day community service project in Chiang Mai in northern Thailand.

ACADEMICS

Mahidol University was started as a medical school and is now a public research university with a large international focus. It is considered by many to be the top university of Thailand. LOCATION: Nakhon Pathom, Thailand

Nicknamed the “Land of Smiles,” Thai people are known for being friendly and generous. Full of attractions, from the mountains in the north to the beaches on the Andaman Sea to the congested capital of Bangkok and Bohemian mecca of Chiang Mai, Thailand draws more visitors than any other South-east Asian country. History and tradition live side by side in the Buddhist temples, historical ruins, mystical mountains, and stunning beaches. Nakhon Pathom is based just outside of the bustling city of Bangkok.

HOUSING & MEALS

All students will stay in shared apartments with other international students. Meals are not included.

CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

Cultural excursions are included in the program, including a four day community service project at the end of the semester in Chiang Mai.
