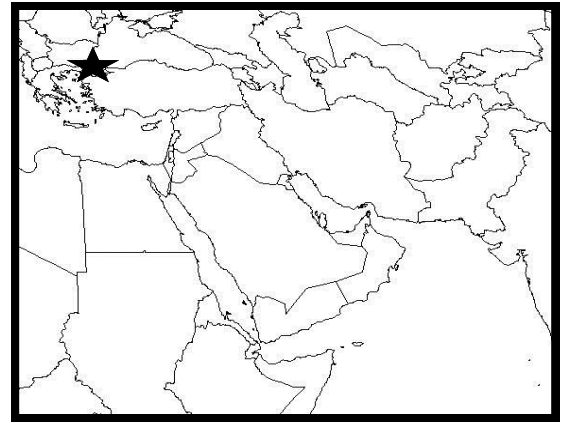

FALL SEMESTER: SEPTEMBER—JANUARY*

SPRING SEMESTER: FEBRUARY—JUNE

*This program ends in mid January. While students are often able to arrange to take exams early, classes end in January and overlap the start of winter quarter at DU.

PROGRAM

This program is offered in cooperation with the Council on International Educational Exchange (CIEE). Koç University was founded in 1993, and courses are taught in English. Students will take Turkish language alongside other international students; other classes will include both Turkish and international students. The university is located approximately 45 minutes from central Istanbul. CIEE offers pre-departure and on-site support, including an extensive orientation and several local and international excursions.

ACADEMICS

Students typically take five classes. All students are required to take a Turkish language class. CIEE offers a 3 credit course specifically for CIEE students called Seminar on Living and Learning in Istanbul. All other courses are regular Koç University offerings in a wide range of disciplines, including social sciences, engineering, humanities, natural and physical sciences, and business. LOCATION: ISTANBUL, TURKEY

Istanbul (pop. 12 million) is a cosmopolitan city, and the cultural, business, and artistic center of Turkey. The city was the capital of the Byzantine and Ottoman empires. Istanbul offers much to see and do, including historic buildings, mosques, museums, art galleries, and night life. The city spans two continents: the western part of Istanbul is located in Europe, while the eastern part is in Asia. The University is located on a beautiful hillside campus overlooking the Black Sea, approximately 45 minutes from the central part of the city.

HOUSING & MEALS

Students live in residence halls where they share a room with a Turkish student. Residence halls are available on both the Main and West campuses, 2 km apart. Meals are not included but kitchen facilities are available. Academic year students can opt to live with a host family during the second semester. Two meals per day are included with the host family.

CULTURAL CONNECTIONS

Take advantage of the volunteer opportunities arranged by CIEE—you'll gain new insights into Turkish culture and meet people outside the university context. Volunteer placements are competitive. Students are paired with Koç students who assist you with getting to know the campus and city, as well as with language partners. The program includes excursions to historic and cultural sites in the Istanbul area as well as two or three weekend trips to other regions of Turkey.

Student Costs**:

- Meals (residence halls)

The cost of living varies in other cities and countries. Talk to returnees from the program to find out what personal expenses to expect, but remember that they vary by lifestyle. Check www.xe.com for current exchange rates.

Note: Cherrington status may be revoked at any time due to a change in your student conduct or academic status. Also, the OIE will request your DU transcript; check and clear any holds now to avoid delays in processing your application!

PROGRAM APPLICATION: DUE AFTER YOU'VE BEEN NOMINATED

Once you have been nominated for this program, you will be required to submit the following:

- CIEE online application (Personal Data Form, Academic Information Form, Personal Statement): fill out & submit to CIEE at <http://www.ciee.org/study/apply/>. Print & submit the CIEE confirmation email with your DU application. *DU students do NOT need to pay the CIEE application fee.*
- Home School Nomination Form (This will be sent electronically & completed by your OIE advisor.)
- Academic Evaluation (Use the CIEE online form to select your evaluator who will complete the form and submit it to CIEE.)
- Six passport-sized photographs: *These must be in color and printed on photo paper. Please write your name on the back of each photo and submit them in an envelope.*
- Optional: CIEE Scholarship application: See <http://www.ciee.org/study/scholarships.aspx> for more details regarding CIEE scholarships and application procedures. *Someone from the financial aid office must complete a portion of the application before you submit it.*
