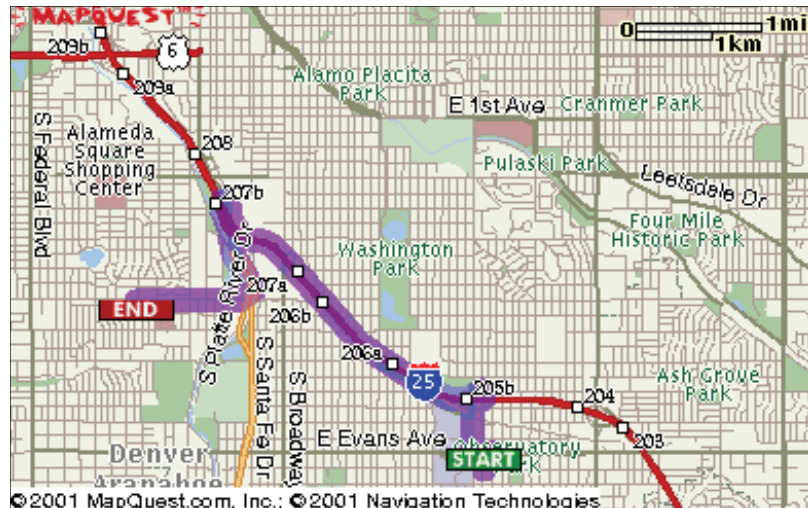

Colorado ID from the Department of Motor Vehicles



The Colorado Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) that is closest to the University of Denver is located at 1865 West Mississippi Ave., which is a few blocks west of Santa Fe Blvd. At this office, you can apply for a driver's license, and/or a Colorado Identification Card (ID Card.)

The Colorado ID is a form of identification that will be helpful for you in administrative matters (writing checks, completing applications etc) and social matters (admittance to certain establishments with age requirements), as well as give you a form of identification in lieu of your immigration papers. However, it does not allow you to drive.

In order to get a Colorado State ID, you need to verify your identity and proof of lawful presence by showing two or more documents. As an international student, you will need to bring in your **original passport, visa, I-94, and I-20 or DS-2019**. *Note:* If you do not have a social security number, you will need to obtain a letter of denial of social security number from the Social Security Administration first and bring the letter with you to the DMV.
