## Summer Travel Reminder

### F-1/J-1 Travel Outside the U.S.

If **you** are an international student and decide to travel outside of the United States during the summer vacation remember to have the following items with you when you return:

- \* Passport valid for the next 6 months,
- \* Form 1-20 signed by an ISSS advisor or a Form DS-2019 signed by your program sponsor within the last 9 months,
- \* Valid F-1 or J-1 visa,
- \* Documents proving financial support for the next 12 months,,
- \* Transcripts showing full-time enrollment every term of the academic year (and less than full-time approval forms, if any).

*If you plan to miss Fall, Winter, or Spring quarter, you **MUST** speak with an ISSS advisor as soon as possible, and keep your boarding pass stubs to prove your absence of less than 5 months.*

*If you plan to be **absent from the U.S. for more than 5 months**, please contact our office to discuss your specific situation.*

### Obtaining a Travel Signature

If you need a new travel signature on your I-20 or your DS-2019, make sure you see an ISSS advisor **before you leave the United States.**

## Travel Signature Dates

If you plan to leave the United States during the summer break make sure to check the travel signature on your I-20 or DS-2019.

Your most current travel signature is valid for up to 9 months from the date it was signed. If you need a new travel signature, bring your I-20 or DS-2019 to the International House to receive an updated travel signature.
