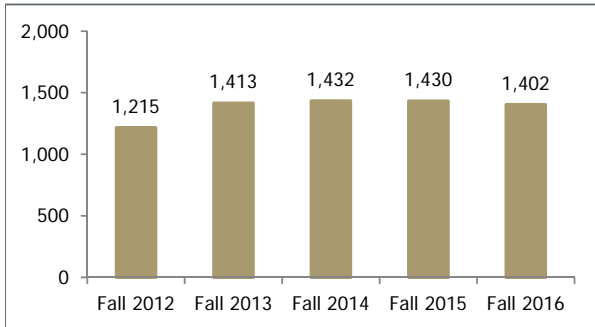
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## FTFY Cohorts—Fall WEEK3

### Summary

#### FTFY Cohorts at Week Three



The Fall 2016 cohort is **2% smaller** than the Fall 2015 cohort.

Statistically significant differences ( $p < .05$ ) are noted as follows:

- ▲ Statistically higher value than the previous cohort
- ▼ Statistically lower value than the previous cohort
