

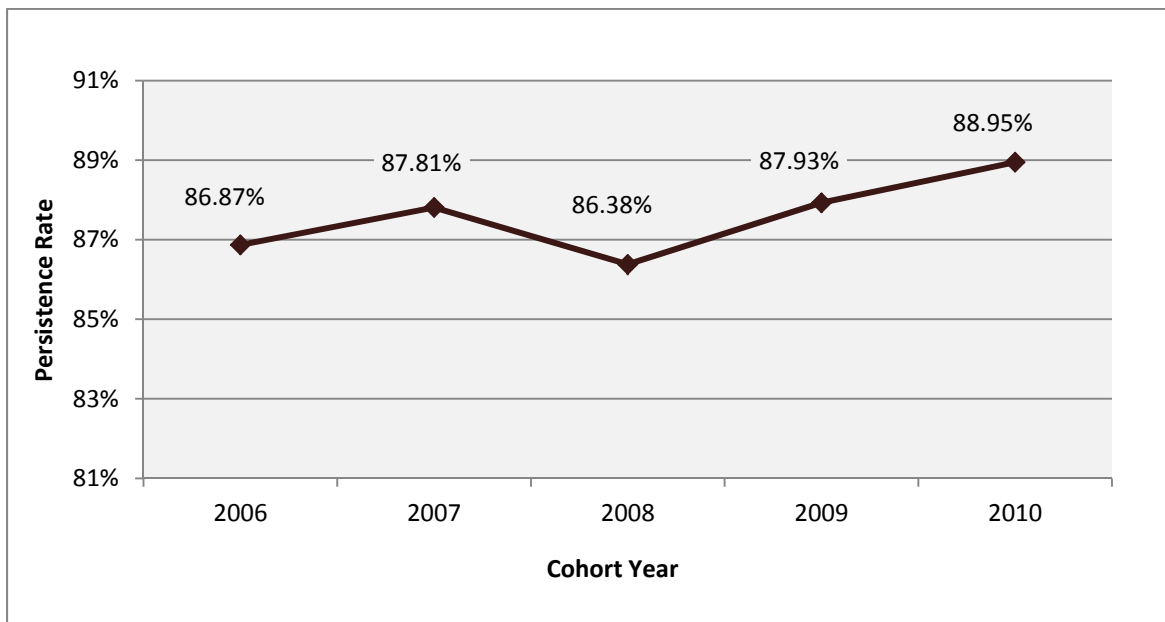

Subject: One-Year Persistence Report – Fall 2010 First-Time, First-Year Cohort - Updated

Please find attached the one-year persistence report of the Fall 2010 first-time, first-year (FTFY) cohort with updated financial need levels. This report excludes students in The Women's College and University College.

- **One-Year Persistence:** 1,095 of the 1,231 students in the Fall 2010 FTFY cohort persisted to Fall 2011, while 136 did not. The Fall 2010 FTFY cohort persistence rate of 88.95% is not statistically significantly different from the Fall 2009 FTFY cohort ($p \leq .05$).

ONE-YEAR PERSISTENCE RATES OF FTFY COHORTS



- **GPA:** Students with a GPA below 2.00 persisted at a statistically significantly lower rate (42.86%) than the overall cohort, while students with a GPA of 3.00 or higher persisted at a statistically significantly higher rate (91.33%) ($p \leq .05$).
- **Non-Persistence Reasons:** Of the 136 students who did not persist, 57 withdrew from the University, 18 took a leave of absence, and 43 had academic, financial, or judicial holds that prevented them from registering this quarter.
