# Chinese Urbanization and 'village enclaves in the city'

## Bio of Jinkui Li



Jinkui Li is currently director of the China Development Institute and Directive researcher of the Urbanization Management Division. He was amongst the first successful university applicants after the Cultural revolution in 1977, having been to “The Great Experience in the Countryside”. He graduated from the Cabled Communication engineering course of Northern Jiaotong University in year 1982 and also from the department of social science in Tsinghua University for second degree in year 1986. He was awarded the “Most Remarkable personnel of Chinese Urban Construction” by the Chinese Construction Department in the Great Hall of People. He founded the Urbanization Management Division of China Development Institute in 200. He arranged and managed the research and consultation project upon urbanization strategies and urban management.

Li held a “Landscape Sociology” program in the Landscape College of Beijing University, using sociology investigation, teamwork, case studies and expert reviews with alike methods. He helped the research students from the course to grasp upon sociology methodologies, to further gain understanding of the social significance and social implication of the subject studying. Closely attaching educational techniques like case studies with reality is the hallmark of Jinkui’s teaching character which made him the most popular teacher of the National Mayor’s class.

Li recently proposed a number of innovative political viewpoints and standpoints in a number of government consultations including allowing the forced immigrant from reservoir constructed areas enter urban areas with land usage allowance certificates; having urbanization strategies incorporated with the unification plan of urban—rural areas; allowing countrymen to be attached to and participate in urbanization using collectively owned land resources for construction usage; having people at the root of urban planning and urban management, etc.

Li’s publications include the highly referred *Real question behind Village in the Urban area* and *The warning to China from the most significant communism revolution event in the history*. He is the author of the Best seller Urban book *Ten Major Choices of Urban Management* by Haitian Books 2002.
