Application Fee

A \$60 online application fee is required.

One Set of Official University Transcripts (including English translations when applicable)

Sent by current institution, and any previous institutions, with an official envelope bearing an official stamp across the envelope's seal. Unofficial transcripts from the University of Denver are acceptable.

Exam Scores

Official Graduate Record Examination, (GRE) scores which have been taken within the last five years.

Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation sent through our online system (preferred) or in sealed envelopes with the recommender's signature across the seal. Both of these recommendations must come from professors in the Josef Korbel School of International Studies.

Statement of Purpose

A 500 to 750 word essay which describes your career goals and objectives and how the proposed degree program at the Josef Korbel School will help in the achievement of those goals.

Resume/Curriculum Vitae (CV)

Proof of Permanent Residence (U.S. Visa Holding Residents Only)
