Application Fee

A \$60 online application fee is required

Official Transcripts (including English translations when applicable)

Send in an official envelope bearing an official stamp across the envelope's seal

Exam Scores

Official Graduate Record Examination, (GRE) scores which have been taken within the last five years (mid-career and certificate programs do not require GREs).

Letters of Recommendation

Two letters of recommendation sent through our online system (preferred) or in sealed envelopes with the recommender's signature across the seal.

Statement of Purpose

A 500 to 750 word essay which describes your career goals and objectives and how the proposed degree program at the Josef Korbel School will help in the achievement of those goals.

Resume/Curriculum Vitae (CV)

Proof of Permanent Residence (U.S. Visa Holding Residents Only)

PRIORITY DEADLINES

January 15- Fall quarter (Sept. matriculation)

As a Dual Degree applicant you must apply to the Josef Korbel School and to another school within the University of Denver at which you will also be pursuing a degree.
