

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Complete Application**
Online application is available at: www.du.edu/korbel
- Application Fee**
A \$60 online application fee is required
- An Official Transcript from each undergraduate institution** (including English translations when applicable)
Send in an official envelope bearing an official stamp across the envelope's seal
- Exam Scores**
Official Graduate Record Examination, (GRE) scores which have been taken within the last five years (stand alone certificate programs do not require GREs).
- TOEFL or IELTS Scores**
Required for all non-English speaking applicants unless the university whereby the conferred undergraduate or graduate degree was instructed in English. Exam scores cannot be older than two years.
- Two Letters of Recommendation**
Names and e-mail addresses of two recommenders will be requested in the online application. Once the completed application is submitted, your recommenders will receive an e-mail requesting to submit a letter through our electronic system. Please speak with your recommenders prior to submitting your application because once your application has been submitted your recommenders will be contacted.
- Statement of Purpose**
A 500 to 750 word essay which describes your career goals and objectives and how the proposed degree program at the Josef Korbel School will help in the achievement of those goals. Submit this document through the online application
- Resume/Curriculum Vitae (CV)** Submit this document through the online application.
