

Joint IFC/PHC Alcohol Policy

The Interfraternity Council and the Panhellenic Council of the University of Denver hereby establish the following Joint Alcohol Policy for its member's chapters in order:

To aid in ensuring a positive and equitable Greek experience for all members
To utilize the educational role which our chapters play in developing member's attitudes toward the responsible use of alcohol.

To affirm the system's tradition of commitment to responsible and innovative self government

To reduce problems associated with the use of alcohol at social events

To increase awareness and promote the safe and responsible use of alcohol by members

To reduce the legal liability risk for officers, members, corporation boards and chapters at the University of Denver.

General Provisions

- A. There is no alcohol in the common spaces of any fraternity or sorority house.
- B. The possession, use and/or consumption of alcoholic beverages must be compliance with the following:
 - State, Federal and local laws
 - The chartering national fraternity or sorority
 - The IFC/PHC Councils and
 - The University of Denver Code of Conduct
- C. Events involving alcohol in the chapter house that are restricted to a single chapter's alumni/ae and spouses and/or parents/siblings are subject to prior approval from the Office of Greek Life.
- D. No alcohol may be purchased through the chapter treasury nor may the purchase of alcoholic beverages for the members or guest be undertaken or coordinated by any member(s) in the name or on behalf of the chapter (ie passing the hat, slush fund, selling of cups, etc.)
- E. The purchase and/or use of bulk quantity of alcoholic beverages, ie kegs, common source containers, is prohibited
- F. If busses are taken to an event, security must be present at the bus stop and Campus Safety must be notified of the event.
- G. Events held outside are subject to the city noise ordinance and must be discontinued outside by 10:00pm.

H. No Policy can cover all the possible situations that may arise. When this policy is not specific in a certain point, member chapters are expected to conduct their activities in the spirit of social responsibility.
