

PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

1. We **do not** require that you submit scores for the psychology GRE subject test; however, the general scores are **required**. The Department highly recommends you mail a photocopy of your scores directly to the department.
2. Three letters of recommendation are **required**.
3. Our deadline is **December 1st** for all of our programs. The Graduate School asks that you send the materials to them several weeks earlier than the deadline. We encourage you to do that in case something is missing, **but we will give full consideration to all applications received by December 1st**.
4. Upon acceptance you will need to fill out the necessary financial aid forms (Free Application for Federal Student Aid).
5. In addition to our Ph.D. program, the University has a School of Professional Psychology that offers a Psy.D. degree. This program **is not** associated with our department and requires a separate application. If you are interested in the Psy.D. program, please contact their office directly at 303-871-3873.
