Preference is given to students who have fewer than 75 hours of university credit.

____ The **Bernard Spilka Undergraduate Scholarship** is awarded to the Junior or Senior most likely to make a significant contribution to the field of Psychology. Eligible students are Psychology majors, will receive need or merit-based financial aid next year,* have a 3.0 or above cumulative GPA, and have 75 or more hours of university credit.
