



Transfer Students To Do List

1. Register for Transfer Student Orientation. We recommend the 3-day Orientation, September 7-9, 2010. If you are unable to attend, there is a one-day options August 27. **Please note, this earlier session offers no advantage in terms of registering for classes, as seats are often held for Discoveries week.** Please call the Orientation office at 303.871.3860 if you have difficulty registering or to ask questions if you are unsure which orientation option is best for you.
 2. Purchase laptop and all related equipment (cords, start-up CD's, etc.) and bring it to your Orientation Session for configuration to the DU system. Visit <http://www.du.edu/uts/laptops/> for specifications.
 3. If your parents or family members wish to attend Parent and Family Orientation on Tuesday, September 8, please have them register by visiting the Parent and Family Orientation webpage.
 4. Review the electronic media sent out by Admissions to learn more about parking, housing and other important information you will need to know as an incoming student. You should receive this by late June.
 5. Send in your information and picture for your [Pioneer ID Card](#).
 6. Explore on-campus living options with [Housing and Residential Education](#).
 7. Check out [meal plan options](#) through Housing and Residential Education. Even if you are living off-campus you can select a meal plan that will be convenient and simple to use.
 8. Remember to check your e-mail or the Discoveries website over the summer for important information about changes in the orientation schedule, where to meet your first day on campus or if you have other questions.
 9. Health Insurance Waiver – students are required to have health insurance. If you wish to purchase health insurance through DU, please visit <http://www.du.edu/duhealth/general/insurance/index.html/> to learn more. If you have your own health insurance, and do not want to purchase insurance through DU, you must waive DU student health insurance.
