## APPLICATION TO RE-ENTER Undergraduate

All students, including those enrolled in the Stop-Out program, who withdraw from the University for one or more quarters (except Summer Session) must submit the attached Application to Re-Enter before they will be allowed to register for any classes. The following guidelines have been established to guide students through this process. Any questions about this process should be directed to the Center for Academic Resources at (303) 871-2455.

- ◆ The Application to Re-Enter must be submitted to Academic Advising by no later than the first day of the intended return quarter. For students returning from suspension, however, this form and other appropriate documentation must be submitted at least **six weeks** before the first day of the term. Failure to meet this deadline may cause this application to be denied. **Students are encouraged to submit this application at least two weeks prior to the start of priority advising week so that they can benefit from early registration while minimizing registration difficulties.** Contact Academic Advising for dates, or visit <http://webcentral.du.edu/>.
- ◆ Transfer credit for study at other institutions while away from DU is not automatically accepted and is subject to review. Official transcripts must be sent directly to the Registrar's Office before they can be evaluated or approved. Send transcripts to Office of the Registrar, University of Denver, 2197 S University Blvd, Denver, CO 80208.
- ◆ Upon approval of the re-entry application, a letter and registration materials will be sent to the student at the address specified on the front of this form and to the DU email address. Should this application be denied, the student may file an appeal with the Office of the Associate Provost for Academic Resources, 2050 E Evans Ave, Driscoll South, Ste 30, Denver, CO 80208.
- ◆ Registration times for re-admitted students will be listed on the student's registration form, which will be mailed and sent via email to the student. The University's Schedule of Classes is available at <http://webcentral.du.edu>.
- ◆ The student is responsible for clearing any registration holds prior to registering for classes. Registration holds may be viewed at <http://webcentral.du.edu>. - ◆ International students must provide financial verification to the Office of International Admission before the I-20 can be processed.
