- The language requirement is a proficiency requirement; students must demonstrate proficiency equivalent to one year of college-level language study. Depending on placement, students may need to complete 0-12 credits to acquire that level of proficiency. International Studies majors have a more rigorous requirement of proficiency equivalent to two years of college-level language study.
- Bachelor of Music students take 8 hours of a single first-year language sequence or 8 hours of a Natural Science (NATS) sequence. Bachelor of Music students may not meet this requirement by waiving out of a language through an exam administered by Languages and Literature.
- FSEM 1111 is required for all first-year students; it is waived for transfer students.
- For the BA, BFA, and BS degrees (with the exception of Engineering), at least 75 quarter hours must be in upper-division courses at the 2000 or 3000 level.
- The AHUM and SOCS Foundation requirements are distributional. Students with an 8 credit AHUM or SOCS requirement must take two classes from different disciplines, as indicated by the first two digits in the course codes.
- For students entering DU in 2006 or later, one CORE course must be designated as Writing Intensive, as indicated in the schedule of classes.
- CREX Alternatives: Four 1-credit music performance ensembles fulfill the CREX requirement, if the student is NOT a music major and the credits are not being used to fulfill the requirements of a music degree.
