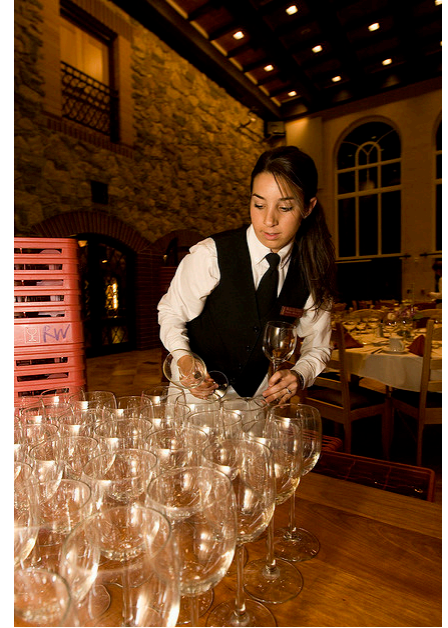

EMPLOYMENT STATUS

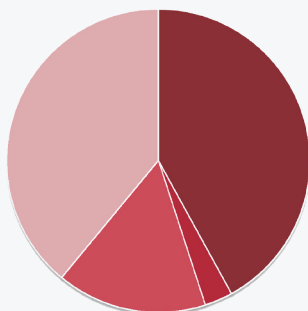
Of Those Seeking Employment (266 respondents)
