- If awarded a partial scholarship, recipient must designate which quarter of the 2015-2016 academic year the funds will be used. Designation must take place at the time the funds are awarded.
- If student is placed on probation by the Office of Student Conduct, this may result in revocation of LEP scholarship funds.
- Priority will be given to undergraduate applicants.
