ITI Welcomes 2010 Class of 22 Transportation Professionals

DENVER, CO, November 10, 2010 – The Intermodal Transportation Institute (ITI) at the University of Denver announced that its newest class of 22 transportation management professionals has begun its Executive Masters Program.

Cohort 9, which began this 2010 Fall Quarter, is one of the largest in ITI's 13-year history and includes three students from the retail shipper industry and four international students, three from Australia and one from Brazil. It also includes a broad spectrum of management professionals from the railroad, ocean-carrier, 3PL, and trucking industries. At the same time Cohort 9 was on campus for its first classroom residency, the graduating Cohort 8 class was also on campus for its final classroom residency.
