**From Airport**

1. Take PENA BLVD west from Airport to Denver.
2. Merge onto I-70 W / US-36 W via the exit on the LEFT
3. Merge onto I-225 S via EXIT 282 toward Aurora / Colorado Springs.
4. Merge onto I-25 N via Exit 1B toward Denver
5. Take University Blvd Exit- EXIT 205
6. Follow signs for University Blvd- Southbound, turn LEFT at S. University Blvd.
7. Turn RIGHT (West, toward Mountains) at E. Evans Ave.
8. Turn LEFT to S. High St.
9. Take an immediate LEFT to Parking Garage E on the southeast corner of S. High St. and E. Evans Ave. Park in visitor section on the first floor.\*

**From Ft. Collins or Colorado Springs**

1. Take I25 to University Blvd.
2. Take University Blvd Exit- EXIT 205. (Exit on right.)
3. Turn **South (right if coming from north; left if coming from south)** at S. University Blvd. Proceed to Evans Avenue.
4. Follow Steps 7-9, above.

E = Evans Avenue Parking Garage; Enter off High Street. Visitor Parking is here, as well as the metered spaces marked with green VP circles on map.
