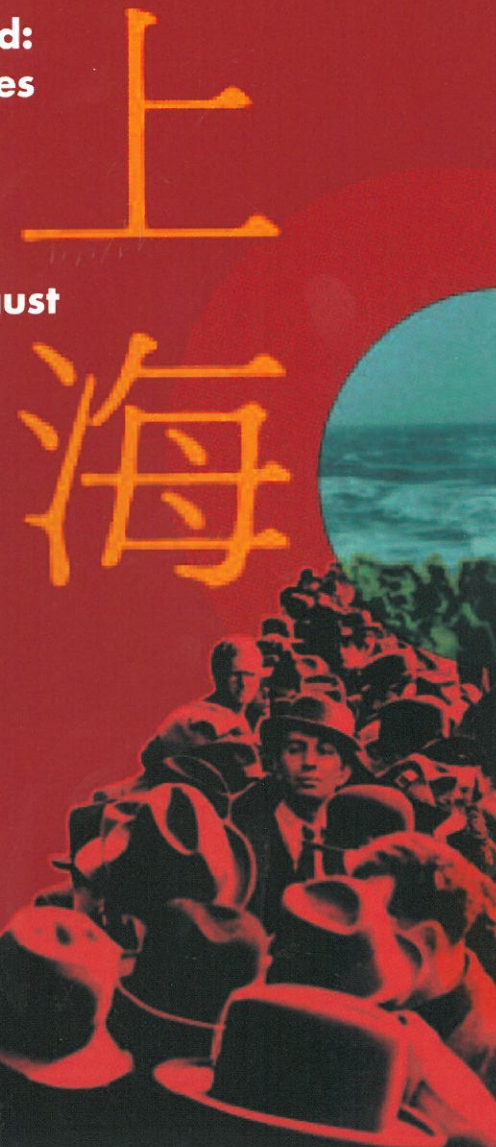

SPEAKERS:

Rena Krasno was born in Shanghai to Russian parents. A well-known lecturer on Jews in China, she is the author of many books, including *Strangers Always: A Jewish Family in Wartime Shanghai*. Ms. Krasno has lived in seven countries and is proficient in six languages. She is the translator of the Fred Marcus diaries and co-author with Audrey Friedman Marcus of a forthcoming book based on those journals.

Audrey Friedman Marcus holds a Masters Degree in Jewish Education from Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion and an honorary doctorate from that institution. She is a nationally known Jewish educator and co-founder of A.R.E. Publishing, Inc. The author of many children's books and the editor of several hundred Jewish educational publications, she is an active member of Temple Sinai.

Fred Marcus, for whom this Holocaust lecture series is named, spent the war years in Shanghai as a refugee from Nazi Germany. An outstanding Jewish educator, he spoke frequently about the Holocaust to school children, organizations, and church groups.
