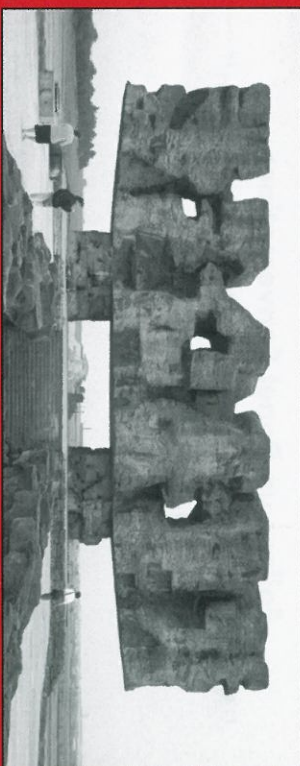

Fred Marcus, for whom this Holocaust lecture series is named, spent the war years in Shanghai, China as a refugee from Nazi Germany.
