Join us to learn more about the Holocaust from the perspective of looted art as Elizabeth Rynecki shares her compelling story, soon to be released as a documentary film, about hunting for lost pieces of her great-grandfather's legacy for over two decades, setting upon a journey to seek out what had been lost but never forgotten.

Elizabeth is the author of the acclaimed book *Chasing Portraits* (2016), the memoir of one woman's emotional quest to find the art of her Polish-Jewish great-grandfather lost during World War II. Moshe Rynecki's body of work reached close to eight hundred paintings and sculptures before he was moved into the Warsaw Ghetto, deported and murdered in the Majdanek concentration camp.
