International Service-Learning: integrates service & community engagement with academic content and critical reflection in a credit bearing course.

Internships: structured, supervised work experience placements. **For purposes of meeting the community engagement criteria, internships should involve a significant level of community engagement; be combined with coursework for academic credit; examine cultural, social and/ or global issues and incorporate critical reflection of these issues with academic material.*
