

## Psychology Minor Requirements

- A **minimum of 20 hours** of courses with prefix PSYC
- BA students: maximum of 60 credit hours in the Psychology Department at DU; hours over 60 do not count toward any requirements
- Minimum GPA of 2.0 overall AND in the minor
- For a PSYC course to count towards a requirement and minimum hours, you must earn a C- or above
  - However, even PSYC courses with D grades count against the 60 hour maximum
