The CCESL Faculty Scholars: Community Engaged Teaching Program is for instructors who are new to using community engagement as a method of teaching. Participants attend a 2-day workshop (December 3 and 4, 2019) and are expected to attend a follow-up meeting in spring quarter. Instructors are also asked to submit a syllabus from their newly developed (or revised) community-engaged course after teaching the course at least once.

Appointed faculty (including Tenure Track, Teaching, Clinical, and Visiting Faculty) are eligible to receive:

- \$750 for attending the 2-day workshop
- \$125 for attending the follow-up meeting in Spring Quarter
- \$125 for submitting a syllabus for a newly developed (or revised) community-engaged course after teaching the course at least once

We anticipate having a limited number of spots for instructors who are Postdoctoral Fellows, Graduate Student PhD candidates, or Adjunct Faculty; unfortunately, these instructors are not eligible to receive stipends.
