Learn more about how undocumented students can get in-state college tuition



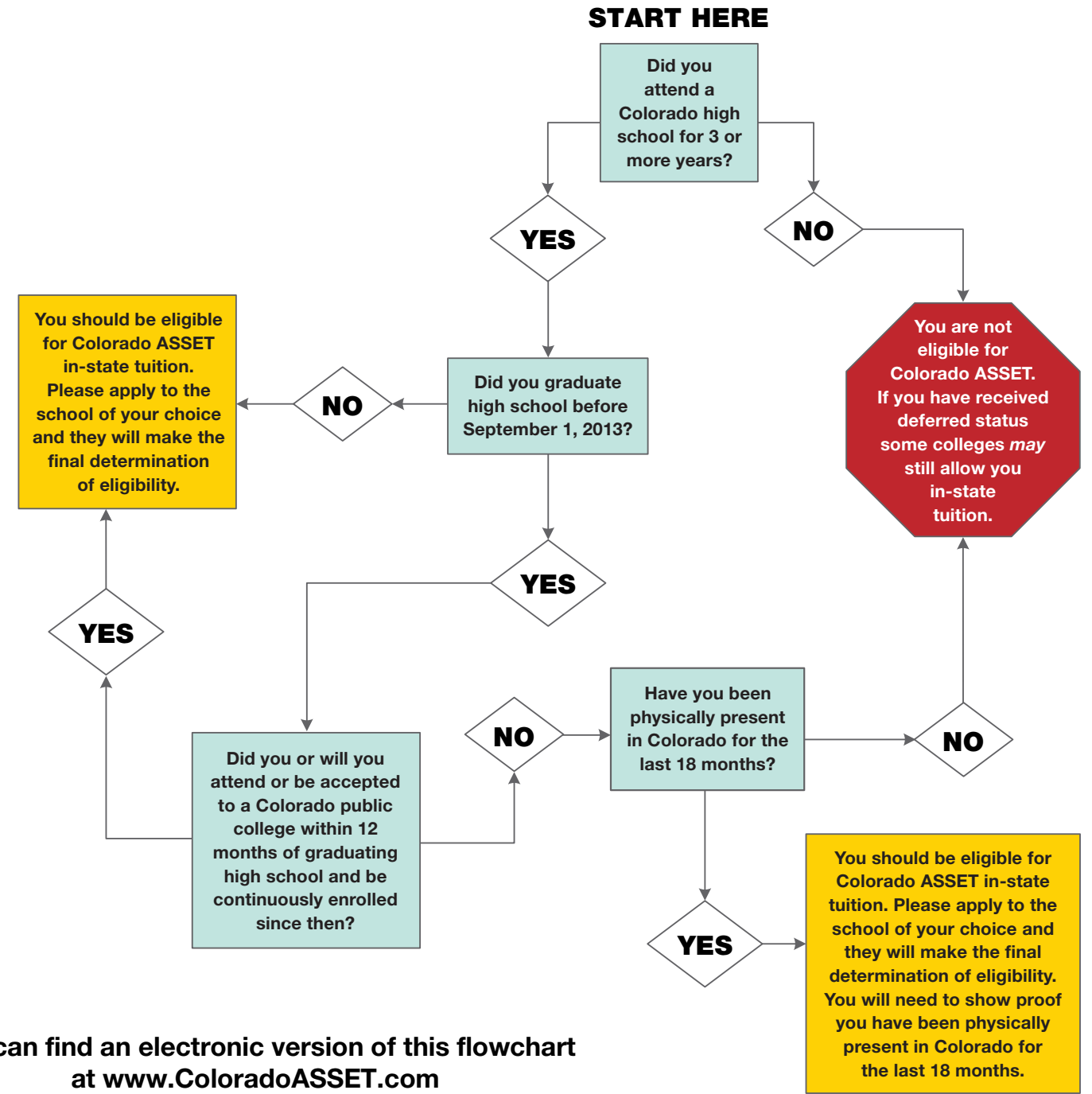
Colorado ASSET, passed by the state legislature in 2013, allows qualified undocumented students to pay in-state tuition to attend a Colorado college or university.

To qualify for Colorado ASSET in-state tuition a student must:

- 1** Have attended a public or private high school in Colorado for at least three years immediately preceding graduation or completing a GED in Colorado
- 2** Be admitted to or already attend a public college or university in Colorado within 12 months of graduation
- 3** Sign an affidavit stating they have applied for lawful presence or will apply as soon as they are able

NOTE: If the student graduated or got their GED before September 1, 2013, there are different qualifying criteria that can be found on our website.
