The noncustodial parent will be required to complete a separate CSS Profile application online at <a href="http://cssprofile.org">http://cssprofile.org</a> using their own login credentials.
Additional Documentation (if requested)  If there is conflicting information between your FAFSA and CSS Profile, or if you've been selected by the U.S. Department of Education for verification, we will need additional documentation in order to verify that your application is correct. If we need further information, we'll send you an email. You must submit all requested documents before we can finalize your financial aid award, so be sure to get them to us as soon as possible.

**Priority Deadlines:** You should apply for aid at the same time you apply for admission in order to receive an award letter around the same time as an admission decision. If you miss this date, you should still apply for aid as soon as possible. We'll continue to send award letters on a weekly basis to admitted students who complete their aid applications after the priority deadlines listed below.
