Nature: Motor Vehicle Theft
Date of Incident: February 21, 2022
Location of Incident: Ritchie Center – east side alleyway

Synopsis:

On Monday, February 21, 2022, shortly after midnight, a red, Chevy Tahoe was stolen from the east side of the Ritchie Center. This crime was reported to the Department of Campus Safety. After viewing camera footage, a white or Hispanic male was seen driving up in a red, Dodge Charger with a primer hood and entering the Tahoe. Both vehicles then drove off. The victim contacted the Denver Police Department as well. This information is being shared with the community per federal law.

While this is a solitary incident, there have been increased reports of thefts from motor vehicles.

Safety and Security Tips:

1. Report suspicious activity immediately by calling 911 and/or 303-871-3000.
2. Do not leave items out in plain view within your vehicle, especially valuables.
3. Always keep a copy of your vehicle registration, license number and VIN on you.
4. Keep your house key and vehicle key separate.
5. Park in well-lit areas where your vehicle is visible.
