Synopsis:

Two anonymous reports of drugging were submitted to Campus Safety.

The first report stated the drugging took place on Saturday, May 14 at The Pioneer. The individuals drugged consumed fewer than three alcoholic beverages over a five-hour time frame but were unable to function (stand, walk, speak, see, hear) and have no recollection of the evening. The report stated that self-administered drug tests were taken the following day and came back positive for benzodiazepines, which neither of the people tested indicated using.

The second report came in with much less detail, though the person making the report stated they were drugged at the Crimson and Gold Tavern or The Gravel Pit on Thursday, May 19.
