

Workers' Compensation Designated Medical Providers

If you do not go to a designated medical provider listed below, your medical costs may be denied by DU's WC insurance.

For **life-threatening** or **serious injuries**, please seek immediate treatment or call 911. This includes all needlesticks (Medicine for Business and Industry, Injury Care Associates, and Concentra all have needle prick procedures).

For **non-life-threatening** medical treatment, select one of the below clinics for medical care. Call the clinic before going in for treatment. Most clinics are open 8 am to 5 pm, Monday – Friday, but **some clinics are open on weekends**.

If you are in CO, you can go to any Medicine for Industry and Business, Injury Care Associates, or Concentra clinic.

For **life-threatening** or **serious injuries**, please seek immediate treatment.
