

DU student pack list for Isolation/Quarantine housing

This is **temporary housing (7~14 days)**; and you may be **carrying this yourself in a single trip**.
Bring only what you need to function and be basically comfortable.

Important information

- IDs, credit and insurance cards
- Cell phone and charger
- List of important peoples' phone numbers written out
- List of any allergies, current medications, and past medical/surgical history

Academics/Schoolwork

- Laptop, charger, and any lightweight accessories
- Textbooks, paper, pens, etc

Toiletries (minimal required)

- Toothbrush + toothpaste
- Shampoo/conditioner
- Soap/body wash
- Shaving supplies
- Feminine/individual special hygiene needs
- Hair comb/brush, hair ties
- Body lotion/baby oil

Linens

- Sheets (Auraria, Vista and Ulofts use full-sized, vs campus-standard XL twin)
- Blanket
- Pillow and pillowcase
- Towel and washcloth

Medications

- Prescription medications
- Cough drops
- Tylenol to bring fever down, help with aches
- Oral Rehydration Liquids (such as Pedialyte) to maintain proper hydration if ill

Miscellaneous

- Tissues
- Hand sanitizer
- Nutritious/comfort snacks
- Refillable water bottle
- Easy, fun tangible activities (eg, coloring book and crayons or a deck of cards)

Clothing

- Several masks/face coverings
- 2+ complete changes of comfy clothes: sweats, PJ pants, tees, fuzzy socks
- Coat/jacket
- Single pair of comfy shoes

Laundry access (and other shared amenities) not available in most temporary housing spaces for public health reasons. Plan accordingly.

We will provide the following:

- Resource handouts
- Trash bags
- Cup
- Toilet paper
- Plastic food storage bags
- Dishwashing soap and sponge
- Dishware (available on request; student responsible for washing)
- Up to 3 meals daily (via daily online order), including drink and cutlery

While we can provide *some* additional household basics on request, supplies and staffing are limited.
Best to prepare a travel set of what YOU will need and want in advance, and bring with you.
