Facilities (non-Union)

This job family includes non-union jobs from many generally related occupations across campus. With the exception of managerial roles, jobs in this family often place greater emphasis on skills and knowledge acquired through on-the-job experience and vocational training than through formal post-secondary education with the exception of some supervisory and managerial professionals for whom some formal post-secondary education is required including advanced degrees and education in specialized fields such as architecture and engineering. Technology plays an increasingly more important role in many of the trade areas (e.g. HVAC). Jobs in this family can also provide law enforcement, security, and safety services. These positions ensure order, safety, and security by providing law enforcement activities, security services, and support for these functions.
