2018-19 CSS Profile - Due by March 15 Website: http://cssprofile.org DU School code: 4842 This application is used to determine your eligibility for institutional aid. (The CSS PROFILE is not required for music majors, or for students in the Colorado Women's College or University College.)
2018-19 CSS Profile for the Noncustodial Parent - Due by March 15 (if applicable) Required if biological/adoptive parents are divorced, separated, single, or were never married. The noncustodial parent will be required to complete a separate CSS Profile application online at http://cssprofile.org using their own login credentials.
2018-19 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) - Due by March 15 Website: www.FAFSA.ed.gov DU School code: 001371 This application is used to determine your eligibility for federal aid. We strongly encourage you to use the IRS Data Retrieval Tool if you can.
Additional Documentation - Due by April 1 (if requested) We may need additional documentation in order to verify that the information on your application is correct. If we need further information, we will send you an email. You must submit all requested documents before we can finalize your financial aid award.
Financial Aid Award Letter - Early June If you have submitted all requirements listed above, we will send you a financial aid award letter in early June via email. We do not mail awards to continuing students.

Why should I apply by the priority deadline? Applying for aid by March 15th will increase your chances of receiving highly sought-after awards (such as Federal Work-Study) and of getting your financial aid package in a timely manner. Because some types of aid have such limited funding, we are not able to offer them to everyone who may otherwise be qualified. If you miss the priority deadline, that's ok—you should still apply as soon as possible!

Monitor your application status through PioneerWeb. Once you have applied for financial aid and have been admitted to the University of Denver, be sure to frequently log into your account in PioneerWeb to review your financial aid requirements on the Student tab. If you have an item in PioneerWeb with a red flag next to it, there are additional steps you must take. Click on that requirement to learn more. Log in at https://pioneerweb.du.edu.
