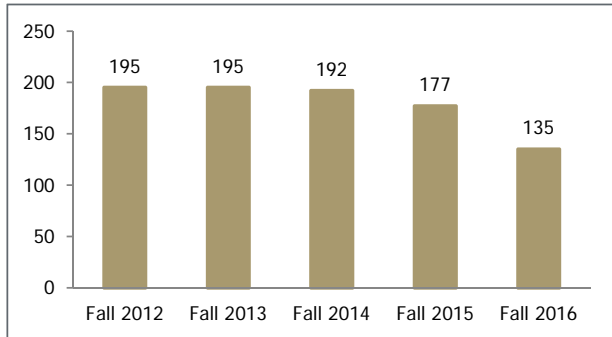

Summary

Transfer Cohorts at Week Three



The Fall 2016 cohort is **23.7% smaller** than the Fall 2015 cohort.

Statistically significant differences ( $p < .05$ ) are noted as follows:

- ▲ Statistically higher value than the previous cohort
- ▼ Statistically lower value than the previous cohort
