

Instructions for F-1 and J-1 Students travelling outside of the United States

To apply for reentry to the United States after an absence of less than 5 months in F-1/J-1 student or F-2/J-2 dependent status, you must present the following at the port of entry (airport or border crossing):

Form I-20 issued by DU or
Form DS-2019 issued for study
at DU with valid travel signature

Unexpired passport valid for
the next six months

Unexpired U.S. entry visa*
