


Printing Your Electronic I-94

- Go to <https://i94.cbp.dhs.gov/i94/#/home#section>
- Click on “Get Most Recent I-94”

- **Enter the information as it appears on the visa you utilized to enter the United States.** If you do not have a visa or you were unsuccessful accessing your I-94 using the information from your visa, enter the information as it appears on the biographic page of the passport you used to enter the U.S.
- **Print document & review your electronic I-94 to ensure that the information matches that on your other documents.**
 - Be sure to check your Name spelling and the Admit Until Date (it should be D/S)
 - Also check your Class of Admission: If you have an I-20 it will be F-1 (dependents F-2); if you have a DS-2019, it will be J-1 (dependents J-2)
 - If your information appears to be inaccurate please consult an ISSS advisor.
- **If you have dependents in F-2 or J-2 status, follow the process above to print I-94's for each dependent.**
