

The University of Denver requires that all faculty, staff and students that conduct research using animals complete the appropriate CITI training modules. This training program is provided and funded by the University of Denver at no charge to the end-user.

The following steps are provided to help you register in CITI (create an account (establishing a username and password)), select the correct course required by DU, to navigate through the program and finally, posting your completion certificate in IRBNet.

Step 1: Go to: www.citiprogram.org to begin the CITI training registration process.
