



Sexually-Transmitted Disease/Infection (STD/STI) Testing Options for Students

last updated February 2017

- **Anonymous** testing means that no names are provided or recorded when the test is performed. The person being tested is given a unique identifier code. Only the person being tested knows the results and nobody will know the identity of the person who had the test performed.
- **Confidential** testing means that a person must give their name before being tested; however, the state health department will confidentially receive the name and test results **ONLY** if test result is positive. Confidentiality laws and regulations protect against other disclosure of the information. If you have a test performed at a doctor's office, it is a confidential test, *not* anonymous.

Cost of visits to see a medical provider or counselor, including tests:

- \$105 if the student did *not* pay the Health & Counseling Fee
- \$10 co-pay if a student pays the Health & Counseling Fee (required for all undergraduates; optional for graduates students)
- Free if a student pays the Health & Counseling Fee AND has the Student Health Insurance Plan

ALL HCC testing is confidential, NOT anonymous. Test results will be recorded in a student's medical record, which is protected by federal HIPAA laws (superseding FERPA protection of wider educational record). These records are NEVER released without the written consent of the individual and can only be released condition by condition. (HCC doesn't do blanket releases of information.)

Offers confidential testing and treatment for a range of sexually transmitted diseases including HIV, gonorrhea, chlamydia, syphilis, genital warts, non-gonococcal urethritis (NGU), pelvic inflammatory disease and various vaginal infections. Patients are seen on a walk-in basis or by same-day appointment. For Denver Health services info or general STD information call 303-602-3540.

Clinic Visits by Appointment

To avoid walk-in waits, same-day appointments can be scheduled for later in the same day by visiting in-person. Hours: Monday-Friday 7:45am-5pm, with lunch closure 12-12.30pm daily.

Free HIV and other STI testing is also offered at the GLBT Center of Colorado (1301 E Colfax Ave, Denver) every Monday and Thursday from 4-7.30pm. glbtcolorado.org/health/hiv-stdtesting

Fees

Residents of Denver, Adams, Douglas and Arapahoe counties are seen free; for all others a fee of up to \$65 may apply. Proof of residence is required and may be demonstrated by a valid driver license or photo ID, with a recent utility bill, lease, bank statement or other documentation. For other counties, check with your county health department about free/reduced STD services.

HIV Testing Clinics offers FREE, confidential, rapid HIV testing. To ensure availability, please make an appointment via 303-837-0166.

- Who: Testing is available to anyone 13 years and older
- When: Testing is available Mon-Wed and Fri 9am-5pm by appointment; and walk-in's (no appointment needed) every Thursday from 2-5.30pm.
- Where: Testing is located at Colorado AIDS Project's offices
- How: Confidential testing is done with the OraQuick ADVANCE® Rapid HIV Test. Results are ready after 20 minutes.
